## PROFILE OF OUR KIDS

- Experience persistent childhood poverty—living below the federal poverty level for at least half of one’s childhood

- Live in inadequate housing and some lack water and utilities
- Live in hotels
- Doubled or tripled up
- Bounce among family members and live in multiple places within a school year
- All have been homeless and spent time in a shelter
- All are one illness, one pay check or one rent increase away from being on the street.
